QWEST'S DEMONSTRATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDERS AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2001 – IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE 18TH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On September 21, 2001, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") entered the 18th Supplemental Order in this matter addressing the process for review of the remaining issues. In paragraph 18 of that order, the Commission required Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") to file a document that lists, for each ordering paragraph in the Commission's orders that required Qwest to either change its SGAT or its behavior to comply with its obligations for a checklist item, the SGAT section or other documentation that demonstrates Qwest's compliance with the orders. Attached hereto is that document.

The document is set up as a table, with three columns. As shown on the column headings, the first column identifies the requirement from either the initial or final order by paragraph number, the second column provides a brief narrative description of the requirement,

QWEST'S DEMONSTRATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDERS AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2001 and the third column identifies the SGAT section that was changed to comply with the

requirement, or other evidence of compliance if changed SGAT language was not required. For

ease of reference, unless stated otherwise, all SGAT references in the attached table refer to the

September 21, 2001 SGAT. However, it should be noted that many SGAT sections were

modified well before September 21 in order to comply with prior orders, and that compliance

language has already appeared in "SGAT lites" or the June 29, 2001 SGAT.

Qwest has included references to the ordering paragraphs from both initial and final

orders, as follows. For any requirements addressed in the final order, Qwest has referenced the

requirement as stated in the final order. Where the final order is silent on an issue that was

addressed by the initial order, Qwest has referenced the requirement as stated in the initial order.

Finally, it should be noted that Qwest has referenced the specific ordering paragraph for each

requirement, not the discussion and decision paragraphs within the body of each order. This is

consistent with the format required by the 18th Supplemental Order.
