RE: Compliance Tariffs for Years One and Two of Two-Year Rate Plan **Docket TP-190976**

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 25, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 09 Final Order Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing in the above-referenced docket. Order 09, among other things, requires Puget Sound Pilots (PSP) to make a compliance tariff filing in this docket reflecting a total revenue requirement of \$35,882,859 in year one and \$36,308,428, in year two of the two-year rate plan.¹ On January 20, 2021, PSP filed its amended compliance tariffs for years one and two of the two-year rate plan with the Commission.

Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed PSP's amended compliance filing and finds that the tariff filing complies with Order 09. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission approve the amended compliance filing and allow rates to become effective on January 25, 2021.
