Dear Mr. Johnson:

Attached please find Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") corrected responses to the COVID-19 Response Term Sheet ("Term Sheet") originally filed on December 1, 2020 (for the periods March through December 2019, and March through September 2020); and February 1, 2021 (for the period October through December 2020.)

Item 8c of the Term Sheet is the amount of past-due balances for known low-income households that are 30, 60, 90, and more than 90 days past due, and the total amount of these arrearages. PSE's original submissions contained errors. The past due balances for some low-income customers were erroneously counted more than once, creating an inflated total. Specifically, the error occurred if the customer had received multiple energy assistance payments or had a single pledge payment credit against multiple invoices. These corrections have been incorporated into Attachments A and B under the tab and columns for item 8c.
