


Verizon Northwest respectfully requests this ICB contract become effective February 16, 2007, the date upon which the current agreement expires. The customer executed the agreement on 1/15/07, therefore, the company could not file the contract under the thirty day statutory notice period. With no provision to extend the term, if the renewal agreement filed under Contract No. 1334ICB is not effective on or before February 16, 2007 service would have to revert to tariff at a higher rate or be disconnected because the company is prohibited under law from providing service without an effective contract.
