ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU purchase power from Avista Corporation, as indicated on Attachment A.

ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in Avista's filing to review deferrals for calendar year 2003. ICNU participated in Avista's 2002 Energy Recovery Mechanism proceeding, Docket No. UE-030751.
