

- (3) The laws and regulations of the State of Washington and Commission Orders govern the construction and interpretation of the Agreement Amendment. The Agreement Amendment is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

The Commissioners, having reviewed the information available in this matter and having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
