- On October 20, 2005, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment No. TV-051472 against Jordan River Moving & Storage, Inc. (Jordan River Moving) in the amount of \$22,800.00, alleging 228 violations of Commission rules and household goods tariff, specifically, WAC 480-15 and Commission Tariff 15-A.
- On November 3, 2005, Jordan River Moving filed with the Commission a Request For Hearing, or in the alternative a request for mitigation of the amount of the penalties.
- The Commission will hear this matter pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. Statutes involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within chapters 81.01 RCW, 81.04 RCW and RCW 81.80 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.04.380, RCW 81.80.130, RCW 81.80.280, RCW 81.80.290, and RCW 81.80.330, and under chapter 480-07 WAC and chapter 480-15 WAC, including but not limited to WAC 480-07-145, WAC 480-07-150, WAC 480-07-440, WAC 480-07-450, WAC 480-07-470, WAC 480-07-490, WAC 480-07-490,

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The ultimate issues include whether the penalty should be mitigated as requested, and what actions are necessary for Jordan River Moving to cure previous instances of non-compliance with state law and Commission rules and to maintain substantial future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of chapter 81.04 RCW.

- Petitions to intervene should be made in writing prior to the hearing date or made orally at the hearing. Appearances will be taken. If any party or witness needs an interpreter or other assistance, please fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission. The time and place for the evidentiary hearings will be set at the prehearing conference or by later written notice.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the prehearing conference set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default in accordance with RCW 34.05.440. The parties are further advised that the sanction provisions of WAC 480-07-450 are specifically invoked.
