Since the commission has adopted rules in Chapter 480-75, Hazardous Liquid, Gas, Oil and Petroleum Pipeline Companies – Safety,				

stakeholders and agency staff have identified a variety of issues, and changes in the federal rules that suggest that the commission should review certain rules relating to safety operation of hazardous liquid pipelines. This rulemaking proposes changes to WAC 480-75-300, WAC 480-75-450, WAC 480-75-630, and WAC 480-75-650 and to add a new rule ensuring that pipeline operators comply with Damage Prevention requirements in Chapter 19.122 RCW.

Reasons supporting proposal:

The proposed changes will provide clarity in some areas of the rules, eliminate requirements that are no longer necessary and provide compliance with federal rules.
