- On November 13, 2007, SeaTac Shuttle, LLC (SeaTac Shuttle) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a formal complaint alleging that Kenmore Air (KA) is in violation of certain sections of WAC 480-30 and RCW 81.68. These violations are alleged to result from KA providing scheduled passenger service over a regular route without the authority required under RCW 81.68 and WAC 480-30.
- STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 81, and has legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish auto transportation services under RCW 81.68. The issues in this proceeding include whether the complainant is in violation of WAC 480-36. Statutes that may apply to this matter include RCW 80.01, RCW 81.04, RCW 81.68, and RCW 34.05, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449
- The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a prehearing conference in this matter at 11:00 a.m., on January 10, 2008 in Room 108 of the Commission's headquarters, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

The purpose of the prehearing conference is to consider any requests for intervention, resolve scheduling matters including establishing dates for distributing evidence and workpapers, to identify the issues in the proceeding and determine other matters to assist the Commission in resolving the matter, as listed in WAC 480-07-430.

- INTERVENTION: Persons seeking to intervene in this proceeding must file written petitions to intervene at least three business days before the date of the prehearing conference. In addition, party representatives must file notices of appearance with the Commission, as required by WAC 480-07-345(2), no later than the day before the conference. If any party or witness needs an interpreter or other assistance, they should fill out the form attached to this notice and return it to the Commission. The Commission will set the time and place for the evidentiary hearings at the prehearing conference or by later written notice.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the prehearing conference set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440. The Commission specifically invokes the sanction provisions of WAC 480-07-450 which allow the Commission to seek penalties for a party in default.
