ORDER

1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: December 1, 2007.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: March 1, 2008.
3. The temporary .44% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of September 2007 and October 2007, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of December 2007 & January 2008.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services -current month and one month ahead:
The surcharge will appear on the December 2007 billing and applies to all services provided in the months of December 2007 and January 2008 and in the January 2008 billing to all services provided in the months of January 2008 and February 2008.
