To All Solid Waste Customers of Sanitary Disposal, Inc:

Sanitary Disposal, Inc. has filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission a solid waste collection rate increase of approximately 10% (excluding past thru fees, which remain unchanged) proposed to become effective August 1, 2008.

Our last rate increase was July 1, 1994. Since that time we have faced increased costs in all phases of our operation, such as labor, equipment, fuel and insurance costs.
