Concerned Citizens of Greater Diamond Point do not approve the proposed surcharge on 2 key points:

- 1. Customers were not informed of the Water System Plan until after it was approved by the Department of Health and at a 3/11/08 meeting at Gardiner with Diamond Point residents with Aquarius. The Aquifer Newsletter from Aquarius also states the surcharge of \$5.00 would be utilized to pay for pipe replacement projects only and not to pay back DWSRF loans for storage tanks. We don't have a problem with failing storage tanks. We do have a problem with our 45 year old disintegrating and leaking water pipes.
- 2. Our pipe infrastructure is already obsolete and placing priority of storage tanks over pipe infrastructure is asking for a major system collapse in a low income rural community that happens to be located in Clallam County which is not recognized as a low income county.
- (a) Aquarius still has an open general rate increase. Docket, UW-080926 Filing Details

Summarizing:

- 1. We object to the purpose of the surcharge Storage Tanks over Pipe Replacement as we were told by DOH & Aquarius.
- 2. Extend rate case until customers have at least 30 days to respond. We only received notification from Aquarius of the surcharge case on July 30 & 31, 2008. The Aug. 14th open meeting date is only 2 weeks notice.
