Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 10 for Yakima Waste Systems, Inc., G89.


We respectfully request the Commission approve a general rate increase to recover increased operating costs for labor, employee benefits, fuel, parts and equipment for our Company. The requested increase is as follows: Residential service \$ 91,736, 6.6%; commercial service \$254,045, 6.6%; roll-off service \$186,735, 15%; residential recycling service \$51,420, 25.55%; and yard waste service at \$48,952, 48.33%. The last general rate adjustment was June 1, 2010. During the last general rate review the residential and commercial rates were reduced by 3.86% by the Commission. As the past 12 months test period reflects, this rate reduction has now produced a rate deficiency which we seek to recover. In Yakima County residential recycling and yard waste services are by subscription only.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages as well as supporting documentation, containing the increased rates. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective on November 1, 2011.

A rate notification letter will be mailed to all customers affected by these proposed changes no later than September 30, 2011. A notice letter will also be delivered to the office of the Yakima County Council Chair.
