Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) project to modify a railroadhighway grade crossing at Grand Avenue/State Route 27 in Pullman,

USDOT # 808010S

On January 15, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded the Washington & Idaho Railway (WIR) a GCPF grant in the amount of \$19,999.50 to modify and improve active warning devices at the Grand Avenue/State Route 27 crossing in Pullman. The USDOT is #808010S. The estimated project cost was \$19,999.50 with WIR paying for all costs exceeding that amount.

On April 8, 2013, the WIR submitted a request for reimbursement for work pursuant to Commission order. Because the commission does not currently have its own signal inspector, Stan Versnick, a certified FRA signal inspector, conducted a site visit on April 16, 2013, and verified that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
