THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- The application filed in Docket TC-130856 to transfer all rights in the state of Washington from Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC, d/b/a Vashon Shuttle, C-1083, to Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC, d/b/a Vashon Shuttle, C-1047, is granted
- 7 (2) Certificate of public convenience and necessity C-1083 is reissued to Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC, d/b/a Vashon Shuttle, and certificate C-1047 is amended as described in the attached Appendix A.
- 8 (3) Certificate of public convenience and necessity C-1083 is cancelled.
- Granting authority for the transfer of rights under a certificate does not necessarily approve the amount involved in the transaction, nor does it bind the Commission to recognize the amount in placing a value for rate-making purposes on the property of the certificate holder.
- 10 (5) The tariff and time schedule for Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC, d/b/a Vashon Shuttle, C-1047, shall be effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this Order.
- The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(6)(c).

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.
