To our customers:

Airporter Shuttle's fares (tariff) are regulated by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). We have filed a request of the UTC to increase rates on our scheduled Airporter service.

We are requesting that this increase be effective on the 27<sup>h</sup> of July 2013.

If approved, this will be our first fare increase since 2005. The following rate table illustrates some sample rates which represent approximately 90 percent of the passenger miles traveled. Generally the proposed increases for the routes that are not listed range between \$3 to \$5, except for routes north of Birch Bay. The fares for these routes to Blaine and Lynden may increase \$12.
