RULE 2 – SERVICES (Continued)

could be logically served by one pipe line will be considered a service. Only one customer will be permitted on a service except by approval of the company.

RULE 3 – SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGE

See tariff for connection charges.

RULE – 4-a DISCONNECTION VISIT CHARGE

When a Utility employee is dispatched (single visit) to disconnect service, that employee must accept payment of a delinquent account and disconnect visit charge. The disconnect visit charge is \$20. If amount owing is tendered in cash, Utility employee will not be required to dispense change for excess of the amount due and owing. Any excess payment will be credited to the customer's (T) account. The Utility will restore service when the cause of discontinuance has been removed and payments of all proper charges due from customer have been made.

RULE – 4-b RECONNECTION VISIT CHARGE

When a Utility employee is dispatched (single visit) to reconnect service to the Utility distribution system, a reconnection visit charge will apply. The reconnection charge is \$25. Such charge is to apply only in cases where service – which includes, but is not limited to, has been (T) discontinued for non-payment of delinquent account, request of the customer (seasonal reconnection), cross connection control (no proof of backflow assembly), backflow assembly testing (annual testing report is not provided) and refusal to make proper repairs or similar cause. No charge will be made for reconnection of service if the shut-off was made for the convenience of the Utility in making repairs, changes, etc. Reconnections requested to be completed after 5 p.m. Monday – Friday, a charge of \$40 will be made.

RULE 5 – SERVICE CONNECTIONS

The company will construct service connections of a proper size, as determined by the company, from its distribution mains to the customer's property. The company reserves the right to refuse to construct a service connection to any property in case a reasonable doubt exists as to continuity of service, or in case the applicant's pipes are not properly constructed and protected.

RULE 6 – INSTALLATION OF METERS

The company reserves the right to meter any flat rate service at its convenience, the company's metered service rates there upon to become effective, provided the customer has received 30 days written notice. All meters so placed will be installed and maintained by the company without cost to the customer.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULE 15 – SPRINKLING AND IRRIGATION

Water used for sprinkling and irrigation shall be paid for at the regular prescribed tariff rates for such service. The hours for such use shall be as prescribed from time to time by the company, subject to protest by any customer affected and to review by the State Commission.

No person shall use water for sprinkling or irrigation purposes during any fire in the area, and all sprinkling and irrigation shall be stopped immediately when an alarm of fire is sounded and not resumed until the fire has been extinguished.

RULE 16 – PROPERTY ON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS

All distribution mains and those portions of service connections, exclusive of customer owned lines, in or on streets or public highways will be considered utility property and will be maintained by the company at its expense.

RULE 17 – GENERAL

All special cases not covered by the foregoing Rules and Regulations will be covered by special rules to be filed as a part of the company's tariff on file with the State Commission, subject in each case to protest according to law.

The company hereby adopts and makes a part of this tariff the regulations of the State Commission as provided in Chapter 480-110, Washington Administrative Code, as amended June 30, 1976.

RULE – 18 SERVICE/NSF CHARGE

A service charge of \$5 will be made for each new account or change of account responsibility on an existing service. Such charge shall be included in the initial billing to the customer.

An additional charge of \$5 is applicable when the utility must dispatch an employee to establish a base meter reading. A charge of \$17 will be made for handling NSF checks. (I)
