The purpose of this filing is to replace the filing which was made yesterday (September 7, 2016) as several pages were missing which was brought to our attention by WUTC Staff. This filing will remove, grandfather and/or modify certain services and features offered by the Company. The Company will not be offering these services due to changes in network facilities. These services include Hotline, Warm Line and Repeat Dialing (Pay Per Use only) which will be removed from the tariff as there are no customers. Repeat Dialing will still be available on a monthly flat rate basis.

Additionally, with this filing we will be renaming Combination Main Station Service to Off Premise Extension in an effort to standardize our language across all TDS Companies. Along with the OPX language standardization we will be grandfathering OPX provisioned in or through the Central Office. We do not yet have customer counts on this service as it is done with a switch audit at the time of conversion. A copy of the Customer Notice is included. Customers will be notified with their September bills.
