RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against J & B Enterprises in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket DG-170350

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 11, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against J & B Enterprises (J & B Enterprises or Company) in the Amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission provided the Company the opportunity to suspend the entirety of the penalty subject to the following conditions: (1) J & B Enterprise owners and all crews complete NUCA Dig Safe Training within 12-months of the Penalty Assessment, and (2) J & B Enterprise commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12-months of the Penalty Assessment. If the Company complied with both conditions, the Commission would waive the suspended penalty.

On July 6, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that J & B Enterprises had met both of the conditions. In its letter, Staff recommended the \$1,000 suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission agrees that J & B Enterprises has complied with the conditions of the suspension offered in the Penalty Assessment. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
