## NOTICE WITHDRAWING PENALTY

RE: Richard D. Worrell, Commission Staff's Request to Rescind Penalty Assessment Docket TV-170551

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 27, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued and served a Penalty Assessment against Richard D. Worrell in the amount of \$1,000, alleging violations of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods companies to file annual reports and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year.

On August 28, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed with the Commission a Request to Rescind the Penalty Assessment. Staff explained that on April 26, 2017, the Company filed a complete annual report, but Staff failed to process the report and designate it as complete.

Because the Company's report was timely filed and the Penalty Assessment was issued in error, the Commission withdraws the penalty assessed against Richard D. Worrell.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that the penalty of \$1,000 assessed against Richard D. Worrell is withdrawn and Docket TV-170551 is closed.
