RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Yamato Transport U.S.A., Inc.

Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance TV-170552

Dear Mr. King:

On July 6, 2017, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,000 Penalty Assessment in Docket TV-170552 against Yamato Transport U.S.A., Inc. for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-15-480), which requires household good companies to furnish annual reports and the regulatory fee to the commission no later than May 1 each year. Yamato Transport U.S.A., Inc. had the option to have \$750 of the \$1,000 penalty suspended on the conditions that: (1) Yamato Transport U.S.A., Inc. files a complete annual report; and (2) pays any outstanding regulatory fee; and (3) pays the \$250 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 15 days of the receipt of the Penalty Assessment Notice.

After reviewing commission records, staff confirmed on August 8, 2017, that all three conditions of the penalty suspension was met as Yamato Transport U.S.A., Inc. filed a complete annual report, paid the outstanding regulatory fee and paid the \$250 portion of the unsuspended penalty. As all three conditions have been met, it is staff's recommendation that the \$750 suspended portion of the penalty be waived and the docket closed.
