Dear Ms. Brown:

Please kindly consider this request for mitigation and abatement of penalty assessment TE-170613 on the basis that Elegant Limo Inc. is experiencing financial hardship and partnership dissolution. The managing partner of Elegant Limo, Inc. left the company in June 25, 2017 taking with him all copies of financial and other business records. This managing partner attempted on several occasions to enter into a close personal relationship with me causing a significant degree of discomfort. I am concerned for my personal safety, security and well being if I confront this person in an attempt to obtain a return of these business records. I originate from India and am of the Muslim faith. I have very significant concerns of my former business partner's past aggressive behaviors and vindictiveness and I do not believe I can safely obtain a return of these records or obtain copies. I am not in contact with my former business partner at all and am reluctant to attempt to do so out of legitimate concerns for my personal safety and peace of mind. Thus, it was not until October 25, 2017 that I received a copy of the Notice of Penalties Incurred and Due assessed by Administrative Law Judge The Hon. Gregory J. Kopta which was served on the departed managing partner on or about June 20, 2017.

Due to the former managing partner's absence and absconding with company documents, Elegant Limo, Inc. has been unable to operate effectively. As a consequence, we have chosen to terminate all licenses for the time being. During this time, the company has experienced financial hardship and has not been profitable. Due to the business' current financial situation, I am requesting that the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission kindly accept a mitigated payment of \$150.00 or alternatively abate the penalty in the entirety.

Additionally, in response to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's request for a 2016 annual report from Elegant Limo, Inc., I do not have the sufficient documentation in my possession, custody or control to support this request. Once again, the managing partner abruptly left Elegant Limo, Inc. and departed with the necessary supporting documentation. Thus, I have suffered additional detriment and hardship due to the misfeasance and my fear of violence of the managing partner.

I surmise that the State of Washington has past financial information from the previously filed

annual reports which would be much more reliable as to gross revenue than my own pure speculation. It is kindly requested that I be provided with copies of this information previously submitted.
