RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against M2 Industrial, Inc. in the Amount of \$1,000 for One Violation of RCW 19.122, Docket DG-171195

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 5, 2018, the Commission issued a penalty assessment against M2 Industrial, Inc. (M2 Industrial or Company) for one violation of RCW 19.122. In the penalty assessment, the Commission offered to waive the entire penalty on the conditions that M2 Industrial employees attend Dig Safe training provided by the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment, and that M2 Industrial committed no further violations of RCW 19.122 during those 12 months.

On January 24, 2018, M2 Industrial filed a response to the penalty assessment, accepting the conditions offered.

On January 11, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that M2 Industrial has not attended NUCA Dig Safe training, and recommending the Commission impose the \$1,000 suspended penalty.

Due to M2 Industrial's failure to comply with the agreed conditions by attending NUCA Dig Safe training, the \$1,000 penalty is now due and payable.
