The following items need to be completed and/or corrected for prompt processing of your application for operating authority. Please complete and return to our office by June 10, 2019. You may not operate until these issues are resolved and you have received your approved permit.

- Request a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) and proof of Cargo Insurance (Form H) from your insurance company. The insurance must show your legal name, and, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) must be shown as the certificate holder. Please ask your insurance company to email the insurance to transportation@utc.wa.gov.
- You put N/A on the Worker's Comp and Employment Security sections on the application. Please explain why.
- You are required to attend commission-sponsored training prior to receiving your provisional permit. We have signed you up for training on June 12, 2019 in Yakima,

WA. If you cannot attend this training you will need to attend the next orientation on May 22, 2019 in Olympia, WA, plus, the required training at a later date. Please contact April Gilson at april.gilson@utc.wa.gov to schedule an orientation if you cannot attend the above-noted training.
