Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on September 19, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Asphalt Maintenance Services, LLC in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2) for failing to request a dig ticket prior to excavation and damaging an underground natural gas facility. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated November 6, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$1,000 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
