**NOTICE WITHDRAWING  
NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL CERTIFICATION AS A CHARTER AND  
EXCURSION CARRIER AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Durham School Services L.P.*,  
Docket TE-191044

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 23, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Charter and Excursion Carrier and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) after it determined that Durham School Services L.P. (Durham School Services) failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay the required regulatory fees.

Under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30-071(2), every charter or excursion company must file an annual safety report by May 1. In addition, under WAC 480-30-076(2), charter and excursion companies must pay regulatory fees each year by May 1. WAC 480-30-171(2)(b) provides that the Commission may cancel the certificate of a charter or excursion carrier if the carrier fails to file its annual report or pay required regulatory fees.

On March 19, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter to the docket indicating that Durham School Services became compliant with WAC chapter 480-30, albeit late. Staff recommends that the Commission withdraw the earlier Notice.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that it withdraws the earlier Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate as a Charter and Excursion Carrier and Opportunity to Request a Hearing issued against Durham School Services L.P. in this docket.**
