TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 31, 2020, the Commission issued a penalty assessment against Velocity Electric Corporation (Vecor or Company) for one violation of RCW 19.122.055. In the penalty assessment, the Commission offered to suspend and ultimately waive the penalty on the conditions that: a) owners of Vecor attend Dig Safe training provided by the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment and b) that the Company commit no further violations of Chapter 19.122 RCW during those 12 months.

On September 16, 2020, Vecor filed a response to the penalty assessment admitting the violations and accepting the conditions offered.

On November 22, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that no representative from Vecor had attended NUCA Dig Safe Training to date and recommending the Commission impose the suspended \$1,000 penalty for failing to meet the conditions.

Due to the Company's failure to comply with the agreed conditions requiring the Company to attend NUCA Dig Safe Training, the \$1,000 suspended penalty is now due and payable.
