Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the Notice of Penalty order for Lynx Landsite Development (Lynx or Company) dated September 2, 2020. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

• \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive the full \$1,000 penalty amount if Company management and field crew responsible for excavation complete Dig Safe Training through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the penalty assessment and incur no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On September 16, 2020, Lynx notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions. On April 13, 2021, Lynx submitted a certificate of completion for NUCA Dig Safe training. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes Lynx has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$1,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
