Dear Ms. Maxwell

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for RP Development (RP or Company) dated April 29, 2021. Compliance with the order required the following items to be met:

- \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive an \$800 portion of the penalty amount on the conditions: (1) the Company supervisors and applicable field staff attend NUCA Dig Safe online Training and; (2) the Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On May 18, 2021, RP signed the acceptance of conditions and made a \$200 payment, submitted verification of training completion, and has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes RP has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close the docket.
