Enclosed is proposed tariff pages from Tariff No. 8 for Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. G-58. The purpose of this tariff filing is a general rate case increase request. As of September 1, it has been two years since the last general rate increase for this company.

During that period, the company has incurred significant increases in costs that are essential to delivering services, including labor, fringe benefits, insurance, fuel, maintenance expenses along with federal and state employement taxes. The company also continues to acquire new assets to ensure it can deliver the safest, most efficient and reliable service possible for its customers.

If approved by the Commission, the overall revenue requirement increase request reflected in this filing would be approximately \$2,126,500 before taxes or 12.15% to approximately 17.5%. The rate increase is spread equally among all classes of customers.
