NOTICE OF ERRATA TO ORDER 01

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Becker Trucking, Inc., et al*,

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 12, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Initial Order Granting Motion to Dismiss Complaint Against Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc., Miracle Man Movers, LLC, and Whidbey Logistics, LLC; Granting Motion to Find Remaining Companies in Default and Cancel Household Goods Carrier Permits for Failure to File Annual Reports and Pay Regulatory Fees (Initial Order). The Initial Order became final on February 3, 2023.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the Initial Order mistakenly held Move Me Do, LLC, (Move Me Do or Company) in default and canceled its permit for failure to file a 2021 annual report or pay regulatory fees. Move Me Do was not operating in 2021 and was therefore not required to file a 2021 annual report or pay regulatory fees and so should not have been included in the Complaint in this Docket. The Commission hereby corrects the Initial Order to remove reference to Move Me Do. A corrected Initial Order is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
