Dear Mr. Killip:

On July 6, 2023, *Matvey Construction Inc.* was issued a \$1,000 penalty for a violation of RCW 19.122.055(1)(a). *Matvey Construction Inc.* was provided the opportunity to suspend an \$800 portion of the penalty amount and ultimately waived on the following conditions:

- *Matvey Construction Inc.* employees attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment; and
- Submit documentation of attendance of Dig Safe training within 5 days of attendance; and
- Commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the 12 months following the penalty assessment.

On July 11, 2023, the Commission received notification from *Matvey Construction Inc.* that the company admitted the violation occurred and accepted the Commission's offer to suspend the penalty amount based on the stated conditions. The Commission received the required documentation of attendance of training on July 13, 2023, and a payment of \$200 was made on July 24, 2023. *Matvey Construction Inc.* has had no further violations of RCW 19.122.

Staff believes that *Matvey Construction Inc.* has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close this docket.
