
Dear Executive Director Hunter:

At the request of Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) Staff, Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) submits these comments on the proposed revisions to WAC 480-93-015 (Odorization of gas), which would make permanent an existing emergency exemption to odorization and sniff test requirements for operators of certain pipeline facilities.

PSE does not currently operate any pipelines to which the proposed exception would apply, so we do not anticipate any added costs, savings, or operational changes from the proposed update at this time. As stated in our Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) report,¹ PSE is committed to worker safety, and we prioritize safety in our company culture.
