<p>* Company proposes to change (Include Title of Provision, Tariff number and Sheets/Pages being changed): RCW 81.28.050 - The 45 day notice to customers. The 45 day filing requirement</p>
<p>* Present provisions are: A 45 day notice to customers. Changes in Tariffs which increase prices must be filed 45 days in advance with the Commission</p>
<p>* Proposed changes are: As stated in WAC 480-70-271 (2)(a), we are requesting to be allowed to notify customers on their first bill. Per WAC 480-70-276, we are also requesting that the rates become effective on January 1, 2024, which is less than 45 days from our issue date of 12/08/2023.</p>
<p>* Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision: Recent potential interpretations of RCW 81.28.050 make it unclear whether the long standing practice of following WAC 480-70-271 (2)(a) can be done without a LSN when submitting with a disposal-only rate filing. In addition, there was some confusion which led to our filing at a later date than originally planned.</p>
<p>* Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste): Due to the need to re-file, we are requesting the revision of rates take effect in less than 45 days, we are also asking that the customer notice can be completed as outlined in WAC 480-70-271 (2)(a)</p>
