Enclosed are revised tariff Pages 2 and 7 for the above-mentioned tariff. The purpose of these revisions is to reflect the change in service around Independence Day. Snohomish County recently notified WM and other haulers of its plan to close all transfer stations within Snohomish County on July 4<sup>th</sup>. These tariff revisions add Independence as a holiday listed within our tariff. The addition of Independence Day as an observed holiday applies only to trash collection services as recycling and yard debris will still be collected on those days. MSW service will be collected on the customer's following service with double the amount of trash service available.

Additionally, due to the timing of the change, I am including an LSN request to have the change added prior to Independence Day.
