## Re: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Notice of Penalty - D-240630

Dear Mr. Kislenko:

As you are aware, on September 6, 2024, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against NW United Exteriors in the amount of \$4,000 for violations of state laws. The penalty or response was due within 15 days of your receipt of the assessment. On November 8, 2024, a Final Notice was sent to you showing a balance of \$4,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$4,000 balance.
