Tariff No. 6. Customer notifications.

*** Present provisions are:**
RCW 81.28.050 - 45-day notice to customers for tariff rate changes.

*** Proposed changes are:**
Waive RCW 81.28.050 and allow customers to be notified on the first bill reflecting the rate increase pursuant to 480-70.271(2)(a)(ii).

*** Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:**
The company received notification from Finley Buttes Landfill notifying that their rates are increasing effective March 1, 2025. Additionally, we received notice from Sudbury Landfill that rates increased on January 1, 2025.

*** Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):**
The historic practice is to notify customers of a Tip Fee increase on the first bill per WAC 480-70-271(2)(a). This allows us to keep rate payer costs down by avoiding unnecessary additional printing and postage.
