RE: Tariff Submittal – Tip Fee Increase, Tariff Number 4, Waste Connections of Washington, Inc. G-253.

Dear Mr. Killip

Our company has been notified that the tipping fee in Clark County will increase from \$111.94 to \$117.04 per non-drop box ton, a 4.56% increase, and from \$99.43 to \$104.14 per drop box ton, a 4.74% increase, effective January 1, 2025. We project this will increase revenue for residential service by \$416,600 (2.19%); for commercial service by \$191,500 (2.27%); and drop box service by \$150,000 (4.74%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 78,000 residential, 4,000 commercial and 400 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by the Commission was effective September 1, 2025.

We respectfully ask that this filing be accepted under LSN, per WAC 480-70-276 for customer notification. If the LSN is accepted and these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the rates will become effective on January 1, 2025. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
