Dear Jeff Killip:

On January 29, 2025, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) submitted revised tariff sheets and supporting workbooks for Schedule 97, Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism Adjustment and for Schedule 99, Production Tax Credit Tracker Adjustment. This compliance filing was made in response to Final Order 02 issued on January 28, 2025, by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) in this docket, accepting the multiparty settlement agreement without condition.

The revisions to these schedules reflect a 20.6 percent increase in Schedule 97 and a 0.3 percent increase in Schedule 99. The compliance filing reflects an effective date of February 1, 2025, which aligns with Final Order 02. Additionally, the revised tariff sheets properly reflect the reduction of \$1.7 million in net recovery resulting from Commission determinations,¹ and satisfies the other terms of the settlement agreement.

Commission staff (Staff) reviewed the Company's compliance filing and is satisfied that it is in accordance with the Commission's Final Order 02 in Docket UE-240461. Staff therefore submits this letter pursuant to WAC 480-07-880(4).

Staff recommends that the Commission issue a compliance acknowledgement letter pursuant to WAC 480-07-880(5) indicating that the filing appears to comply with Final Order 02 and allowing the revised tariff pages to become effective on February 1, 2025.
