Pursuant to paragraph No. 246 of Final Order No. 6, Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al, Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") provides herewith a detailed report for a qualifying storm event which occurred on December 13, 2006.

The attached document summarizes PSE's formal response to, and preliminary costs incurred as a result of repairing storm damage to PSE's electric system on December 13, 2006. At this time it is anticipated permanent storm repairs will continue throughout March, 2007. Once all repair work is complete and the associated repair costs are finalized, a supplemental Qualifying Events Report will be submitted.

It should be noted that the total O&M expenses resulting from previous 2006 qualifying events have reached the \$7 million threshold for accounting deferral treatment and, in accordance with Order No. 6, subsequent eligible 2006 qualifying event repair expenses are being deferred. This is the eleventh Qualifying Storm Events report for 2006.
