Qwest hereby submits a second erratum to the Petition for Clarification which was filed yesterday. Please substitute the following for paragraph 2 on pages 2 and 3 of the petition:

Changes in PIDs are effective sixty days after filing. Thus Qwest will begin reporting new standards for EELs April 17, 2004. The standards for EELs which Qwest will file in response to the Order represent new product disaggregations for Washington. Qwest has no process to disaggregate new products for payment and reporting on other than a calendar month basis. Qwest seeks clarification that it will be required to process payments to CLECs for performance results for services rendered beginning in May, 2004 for service rendered and reported results beginning April 1, 2004 because Qwest currently does not have the capability by individual product to prorate or apply payments based on less than one month's reported data. Data are currently gathered and reported on a calendar month basis. [Changes are shown in bill drafting format.]
