RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities*, Docket UE-160082

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 28, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Allowing Tariff Revisions to Become Effective Subject to Conditions (Order 01) in this docket. Order 01, among other things, required Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) to file quarterly reports documenting program participation levels, expenditures, and revenues for each service offered under the Pilot Program beginning August 1, 2016.

On June 1, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the quarterly reports filed on February 1, 2017, and May 1, 2017, and found that they complied with the requirements of Order 01.

On February 12, 2018, Staff filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the three most recent quarterly reports, filed on July 31, 2017, October 31, 2017, and January 31, 2018, and found that they complied with the requirements Order 01.

The Commission accepts the reports filed through January 31, 2018, as in compliance with Order 01.
