14 ATTORNEY SYKES: The following week, the  
15 28th.

16 CHAIR DANNER: The 28th. All right. Thank  
17 you for that clarification.

18 All right. Again, this is last chance. If  
19 there's anyone who wishes to speak to the commission  
20 tonight, this is your opportunity to do so. Is there  
21 anyone on the line who wishes to make a comment tonight  
22 to be part of the record?

23 All right. I am hearing nothing. And so  
24 with that, I think we can adjourn unless there is  
25 anything else to come before the commission.


