**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO
JOINT CLEC MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT RESPONSE FILING**

(Due by Noon, Tuesday, February 17, 2004)

RE: In the Matter of the Petition of Qwest Corporation to Initiate a Mass-Market Switching and Dedicated Transport Case Pursuant to the Triennial Review Order, Docket No. UT-033044.

On Friday, February 13, 2004, Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc., Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., McLeodUSA Telecommunications, Inc., Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., and XO Washington, Inc. (collectively "Joint CLECs") filed a motion with the Commission electronically, requesting permission to file a revised Exhibit DRF-5HC to the Response Testimony of Dean R. Fassett to include information provided in responses to data requests and subpoena duces tecum requests that were not available when the testimony was filed with the Commission. The Joint CLECs report that Qwest does not object to the request.

In order to resolve this matter expeditiously, any party who seeks to respond to the Joint CLECs' motion must file a written response with the Commission by Noon, Tuesday, February 17, 2004.
