APPLICATION OF RATES - GENERAL

Collector may charge additional amounts for disposal fees only where specifically stated in the tariff and separately shown on customers' bills.

HOLIDAY PICKUP

15	For regularly scheduled service, when pickup is missed due to the carrier's observance of a holiday, carrier will provide service on an alternate day at no additional cost to the customer. A list of the holidays observed by this carrier are shown in Item 60. For application of rates in this tariff, carrier defines alternate day to mean the following: the day following the holiday.
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CHANGE IN PICKUP SCHEDULE

REFUNDS

When there has been a transaction which results in a credit being due the customer the following shall apply:

1. If the amount is \$5.00 or less, an adjustment will be made to the customer's account. The adjustment will be shown on the next regular bill.
2. If the amount is in excess of \$5.00, the customer shall have the option to accept an adjustment to their account or to request a refund be made. If the customer elects to have an adjustment made, it must show on the next regular billing. If the customer elects to receive a refund, the carrier must issue a check no later than 30 days following the request.

When service is discontinued during a prebilled period and the customer is due a refund, the following shall apply:

1. All requests for refunds will be honored, but refunds under \$5.00 will not be voluntarily offered unless requested by the customer.
2. If the customer provides a forwarding address to the company or one can be obtained from the Post Office, the company will issue a refund check no later than 30 days following the request.
3. The carrier will make an attempt to refund amounts in excess of \$5.00. If the customer does not provide a forwarding address and the U. S. Post Office cannot furnish a forwarding address, the amount may be presumed to be abandoned and subject to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act after the lapse of one year.

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If carriers issue bills on a quarterly basis, the bills may be for no more than two months in advance and must be for at least one month in arrears.

AUTOMATED CARTS:

A cart designed to be picked up and emptied by mechanical means. Specific type and size to be defined in rate items.

BALE:

Material compressed by machine and securely tarped or banded.

BULKY MATERIALS:

Empty carriers, cartons, boxes, crates, etc., or materials offered for disposal, all of which may be readily handled without shoveling.

CAN:

A can must be made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material, watertight, with a close fitting cover and two handles. Size to exceed 20 gallons but not to exceed 32 gallons or 4 cubic feet. A can cannot weigh more than 65 pounds when filled nor more than 12 pounds when empty.

CART:

Wheeled plastic container. If supplied by customer, must be compatible with collector's equipment. May also be referred to as a toter. Size and type to be defined in rate items.

CHARGE:

A set flat fee for performing a service. Or, the result of multiplying a rate for a unit times the number of units transported.

COMPACTED MATERIAL:

Material which has been compressed by any mechanical device either before or after it is placed in the receptacle handled by the collector.

COMPACTOR DISCONNECT

/RECONNECT CHARGE:

A flat fee established by the solid waste collection company for the service of disconnecting a compactor from a drop box or container prior to taking it to be dumped and then reconnecting the compactor when the drop box or container is returned to the customer's site.

CONTAINER:

A detachable container which is left at a customer's premises and emptied into the collector's truck and is lifted by mechanical means.

DROP BOX:

A container which is placed on collector's truck by mechanical means, hauled to disposal site and returned to customer's premises.

DRUM:

A metal container of approximately 50 gallon capacity, generally used for oils or solvents. Maximum weight not to exceed 65 pounds when filled.

GATE CHARGE:

A flat fee charged for opening, unlocking or closing gates in order to pick up solid waste.

LITTER RECEPTACLE:

A container not over 60 gallon capacity generally placed in shopping centers and along streets or highways for litter. Maximum weight not to exceed 65 pounds when filled.

LOOSE MATERIAL:

Material not set out in bags or containers. Also includes materials which must be shoveled.

MINI-CAN:

A can made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material, watertight with a close fitting cover. Size not to exceed 20 gallons, nor weight to exceed 35 pounds.

PACKER:

A device or vehicle specially designed to pack loose materials.

PASS THROUGH FEE:

Pass through fees are shown in Item 230. They are fees that are billed directly to the customer without markup or markdown by the solid waste collection company.

PERMANENT SERVICE:

In conjunction with containers and drop boxes, when service is provided for a period of more than ninety days.

RATE:

A price per unit or per service. A rate is multiplied times the number of units transported, or the number of times a service is performed to determine a hauling charge.

RECYCLING BIN OR

CONTAINER:

A bin or container specifically designed or designated for the collection of recyclables. Each carrier's tariff will contain reference to a specific type of bin or container to be used by customers in a service area. Often the type, size, weight, etc., of this type of bin or container is set by

DEFINITIONS, Continued:

SPECIAL PICKUP:

A pickup requested by the customer at a time other than the regularly scheduled pickup time, But which does not involve the dispatch of a truck. If a special dispatch is required, time rates as shown in Item 160 will apply.

SUPPLEMENT:

A page added to the beginning of a tariff, normally to cover emergency, temporary or special situations. An example is a page issued to show a special surcharge imposed by a city.

TEMPORARY SERVICE:

Rates for temporary service apply only when service is required for a period of 90 days or less in conjunction with containers and drop boxes. Temporary service rates are not to be used for the first 90 days of service when the customer requests, and the carrier provides, service for more than 90 days.

TOTER:

Wheeled plastic container. If supplied by customer, must be compatible with collector's equipment. May also be referred to as a cart. Size and type to be defined in rate items.

UNIT:

(1) A can made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material, watertight, with a close fitting cover and two handles. Size to exceed 20 gallons but not to exceed 32 gallons or 4 cubic feet. Cannot weigh more than 65 pounds when filled or more than 12 pounds when empty.

(2) Where agreeable between collector and customer (and where allowable under local ordinance) a box, carton, cardboard barrel or other suitable container may be substituted for a garbage can, for a single pickup which includes the container, if it meets the size and weight limits shown in paragraph (1) above.

UNLATCHING:

Another term for gate charge. A flat fee imposed by a hauler when their personnel must unlatch a gate or door to perform pickup service.

UNLOCKING:

A flat fee imposed by a hauler when their personnel must unlock padlocks or other locking devices to perform pickup service.
