PUBLIC COUNSEL DATA REQUEST NO. 526:

Please provide a description of all tasks that Frontier must undertake to transfer Verizon Internet customers to Frontier. Please provide network diagrams associated with the current Verizon data network in Washington, and illustrate which portions of this network will be transferred to Frontier.

Response:

Applicants assert Objection Nos. 2, 3, 7, 8, 10 and 12. Subject to and without waiver of the objections, Applicants respond as follows:

See attachment WA PC Set31 VZ526 Attach1 WA State Asset Transfer.

Verizon will transfer ISP customers to Frontier at closing.

Certain routers will transfer to Frontier. Frontier will install new circuits from Washington routers to the Frontier National IP Backbone. Frontier will re-home circuits directly connecting to Verizon's AS 19262 to Frontier's network facilities within 12 months of close.

Verizon IP Address blocks will be transferred to support this customer base. Frontier will renumber customer IP addresses from Verizon IP address space to Frontier IP address space within 12 months of close. Frontier will install these new blocks onto network elements and reboot customer modems. This will address dynamic customers. Frontier will work individually with customers that have static IP Addresses to effect necessary changes.
