Please clarify whether or not the Company's modification to proposed rate design applies to any other schedule other than Schedule 23, such as Schedules 51 and 53. If so, please provide the relevant revised pages to Exhibit No. ___ (JKP-7) to reflect the new proposed rate design and bill impacts.

Response:

Please see Puget Sound Energy Inc.'s (PSE) Response to WUTC Staff Data Request No. 410. PSE's modification to its proposed rate design applies to Schedule 23 and Schedule 53 only.

Puget Sound Energy Inc.'s (PSE) Response to WUTC Staff Data Request No. 410 reflects the relevant revised pages to the sixth exhibit to the prefiled direct testimony of Janet K. Phelps, Exhibit No. ___(JKP-7), for Schedules 53 for the new proposed rate design.

PSE's proposed rate design modification is not intended to apply to the original rate proposal for Schedule 51. However, at page 4 of PSE's Response to WUTC Staff No. 410, a revised impacts calculation has been provided to reflect the inclusion of an average of 57 monthly basic charges (the average number of units served by the 6 customers on this schedule).
