Refer to 15:13-15, 22-23. Please confirm that Avista is proposing uniform percentage increases to Schedule 25 energy blocks that are higher than the Company's overall proposed increases to Schedule 25. If the Company cannot confirm, please explain.

RESPONSE:

The Company's proposed increases to the energy blocks as well as the variable demand rate for Schedule 25 are higher than the overall proposed increase to Schedule 25. This is the result of the Company proposing to keep the monthly minimum demand charge at \$21,000 per month.
