Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE" or "the Company") advises hereby, as a courtesy notice, that restoration costs for the first qualifying storm event in 2008 have been incurred, as a result of the June 9, 2008, wind storm, causing qualifying event costs to be accrued toward the threshold for 2008. At this time, however, PSE's qualifying event costs still remain well below the threshold for deferral treatment, and this advisory is being provided for informational purposes only.

The Company will later be submitting an informational Qualifying Storm Event Report, since this storm counts towards the threshold, in accordance with Paragraph No. 246 of Final Order No. 06, Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al.
