Dear Mr. Johnson:

On June 20, 2002, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Twelfth Supplemental Order Rejecting Tariff Filing; Approving and Adopting Settlement Stipulation Subject to Modifications, Clarifications, and Conditions; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 12) in the above-referenced consolidated dockets. Order 12, among other things, through the adoption of Settlement Stipulation, required Puget Sound Energy (PSE, or the Company) to file an annual report with the Commission in this docket regarding the Company's Home Energy Lifeline Program (HELP) by May 31st of each year.¹

On May 28, 2019, PSE filed with the Commission its HELP annual report in compliance with Order 12 and the Settlement Stipulation. The report included information on program expenditure, outcome and outreach in 2017-2018 program year.
